

Codicil Form: Accompanying Notes

The following page is a template codicil form which can be printed out and used to add a gift to the St Vincent's Hospice to your Will.

A codicil is a document designed for minor amendments to your Will e.g. adding a new gift.

If you wish to make any more involved changes to your Will you should consult a solicitor to ascertain whether a re-write of the main document is required.

- Do not try to change or add anything to your current Will by crossing out or writing in new instructions as any changes will not be valid.
- You will need to sign and date the Codicil document and have it witnessed by two people (just like your Will)
- If you wish to make other changes at the same time, it may be best to have the Will re-written to include all your changes in a new document
- o Keep the Codicil with but not attached to your current Will, in a safe place
- Send or give a copy of the Will and Codicil (in a sealed envelope, if you prefer) to your Executor or other trusted friend, with a note indicating where the original is held
